Some of our closest friends don't know it, but Dallas Habitat is a retailer! Since we opened our first ReStore in 1996, we have been offering the public a great way to save money on home improvement items. And while you save money, you are also keeping Dallas green, helping families achieve their dream of homeownership, and creating jobs. That is a big impact from buying a door or an area rug! Here is how:

Keeping Dallas Green

Our ReStores are the epitome of the "Reuse" part of the green slogan: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle. Half of our ReStore stock is donated. Some of the donated goods are new, but are discontinued or surplus items from businesses. Some of our goods are gently used home and building products donated by individuals and businesses. Each year, we keep over 5 million pounds of waste out of landfills by redirecting great products to our shoppers.

And this month we are proud to announce a new partnership with STS Electronic Recycling. We know that responsible disposal of electronics is critical, first, because of the sheer amount of these products in our homes and offices. Electronic products also have dangerously polluting substances in them. The EPA tells us that in 2009 there were 5 million tons of electronics in storage and 2.37 tons ready for disposal, but that only 25% were collected for recycling. Our partner, STS, has a "no landfill" policy and has a R2 Certified Facility – that means that electronics are demanufactured and recycled to the highest environmental standards. STS provides electronic data destruction meeting Department of Defense standards so electronics can be donated at any of our ReStore locations with peace of mind.

Our partnership with STS also means that our ReStores are now offering great bargains on recertified electronics.

Supporting Our Mission

The proceeds from our ReStores directly go to supporting our vision of a world where everyone has a decent place to live. Your purchase at the ReStore has helped us serve over 450 families in the past three years.

Creating an Economic Impact

Like other retailers in town, Dallas Habitat ReStores employ people, buy equipment, rent store space, and collect sales taxes. To operate our three ReStores requires a lot of great volunteers and 20 dedicated staff members. And we collect about \$255,000 in sales taxes each year.
